# Steep Rock Preserve: Tunnel Road Bridge Closed in 2023

The Town of Washington is replacing the Tunnel Road Bridge over the Shepaug River. The bridge will be closed until November. There will be <u>no</u> parking or access to Steep Rock preserve on the west side of the bridge coming from River Road or Lower Church Hill Road. The only access to Steep Rock will be Spring Hill Road off Route 199/Roxbury Road. All horse trailer access and SR1 and SR2 campsites will be closed for the 2023 season.
