Be on the Lookout!


Please be on the lookout for turtles when driving and mowing this month. Females are on the move in search of a place to lay their eggs. Often that means traveling long distances on land, crossing roads, and frequenting yards. If you come across a turtle that can be safely escorted out of harm's way, carefully pick them up by the shell and move them the shortest distance possible, always in the direction they are heading.

Snappers are tough since they can do some damage and can be big, making them difficult (and also situationally dangerous) to pick up. We

don't recommend trying to handle them. If you find one of manageable size in the road or beginning to cross, you can grab them by the shell, obviously from behind. They should never be moved by the tail or head. Thank you for caring about turtles.
