We are thrilled to announce the acquisition of a spectacular 30.46- acre property known as <u>Pinnacle Cliffs</u>. An integral piece of SRA's Macricostas Expansion Project, Pinnacle Cliffs is nestled on the top of the ridge between Macricostas Preserve and the Town of Warren. Preservation of the parcel protects a surprisingly rich assemblage of unique natural communities that converge within a relatively small area and provide important wildlife linkages to surrounding core forests. For adventurous hikers, the parcel offers clues to the region's geologic history, with spectacular glacial erratic formations, including a 65-foot-high cliff topped

by a copse of mature pine trees, and five acres of undisturbed wetlands rarely seen in northwest CT. We are incredibly grateful to SRA Trustee John Santoleri for leading the acquisition process and funding from the state of CT, US Fish & Wildlife Service, John T. and Jane A. Wiederhold Foundation, CT Land Conservation Council, and SRA donors who supported this effort. For more about Pinnacle Cliffs, click here.

Kirby Brook Project Means Happier Fish

The Kirby Brook culvert beneath Tunnel Road in Steep Rock Preserve recently got a retrofit! Our thanks go to Housatonic Valley Association, the Town of Washington, and Trout Scapes River Restoration for making this impactful, collaborative conservation project possible. Previously, the culvert was a significant barrier to fish passage, essentially disconnecting the stream from the Shepaug River. Now, fish can "step" their way up to and through the culvert, reaching quality cold-water habitat and refuge when it matters most. We look forward to seeing teeming fish populations and an all-around healthier and livelier brook ecosystem as a result.
